

**RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS  
BEAR PARK UNIT #2  
Otero County, New Mexico**

The undersigned, James R. Maynard and Susan R. Maynard being the owner of Bear Park Subdivision, Village of Cloudcroft, Otero County, New Mexico, according to the plat filed on August 29, 1995 in Book number 47, page 65-67, plat records of said county, does hereby make the following declarations and covenants as to the limitations, restrictions, and uses of lots. 65-66 JRM

1. All Village of Cloudcroft ordinances shall pertain to all lots.
2. In addition to all Village of Cloudcroft ordinances the following restrictive covenants shall apply.
3. No mobile homes shall be allowed on any lot.
4. All buildings shall be site built, not factory built.
5. All dwellings shall have an attached garage.
6. All buildings shall have 1200 square feet minimum heated living area on at least one level.
7. All exterior walls must extend to grade.
8. All exposed standard concrete block shall have a stucco finish.

Terms: This document and its provisions shall be in full force and effect upon all of the described property from the date of recording hereof, unless amended or replaced by an affirmative vote of 75% of the then lot owners with one vote per lot.
