

AMENDMENT TO RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS

INDIAN LODGE MOUNTAIN SUBDIVISION

OTERO COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

WHEREAS Indian Lodge Mountain, a Limited Partnership, is the owner of the Indian Lodge Mountain Subdivision located in Mountain Park, Otero County, New Mexico;

AND WHEREAS on the 1st day of July, 1981, Sammy Wm. Seek and C. Michael Shyne, both General Partners of Indian Lodge Mountain, A Limited Partnership, agreed upon certain restrictive covenants affecting said subdivision. Those covenants were recorded in Book 504, Pages 583, 584 and 585 of the records of the Otero County Clerk.

AND WHEREAS the above-mentioned owners and the owners of Lots purchased since said Restrictive Covenants were recorded desire to modify Paragraph 10 of said Restrictive Covenants;

NOW THEREFORE, upon recordation of this document, Paragraph 10 of the Restrictive Covenants to Indian Lodge Mountain Subdivision shall read as follows:

No swine, poultry, goats, cattle, sheep, horses or any other livestock may be kept on any lot, unless said lot forms the exterior boundary of Indian Lodge Mountain Subdivision. Those Lots forming the exterior boundary of said subdivision are Lots numbered: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31. Those Lots forming the exterior boundary of said subdivision solely where said boundary is adjacent to U. S. Highway 82 shall not be included in this livestock allowance. In such case where livestock is allowed, as defined above, a total of two head may be maintained on each lot, so long as their maintenance on the property does not become a nuisance or offensive to adjacent landowners, whether by reason of noise, odor or otherwise. All pens and corrals for such animals shall meet the approval of the architectural committee, be located to the rear of the lot, and be built no closer than twenty-five feet to adjacent lots. Under no circumstances may livestock be maintained for commercial purposes. No dogs shall be allowed to run loose. No barbed wire or chicken wire shall be used for fencing or corrals on any Lot.
