

Depending on the Internet browser you are using, follow the steps listed below to download and save the Parcels.kmz.

First, create a folder on your C: drive or other appropriate drive and name it Google Earth. Remember that location.

Internet Explorer:

1. Select the parcels.kmz download.
2. At the dialogue box "What do you want to with Parcels.kmz" select "Save as".
3. Navigate to the folder on your hard drive where you created the folder named "Google Earth" and save it there.

Google:

1. Select the parcels.kmz download.
2. At the lower left of your screen, a download box will appear. When the download completes, click on the dropdown arrow next to it and select "Show in folder"
3. Copy the downloaded file and paste it where you created the folder named "Google Earth".

Mozilla:

1. Select the parcels.kmz download.
2. At the dialogue box "Opening Parcels.kmz" select "Save File".
3. Depending on how your Mozilla download options are set up, it will either save your file to your "User Downloads Folder" or you will be asked where to save it. For the later, navigate to the folder on your hard drive where you created the folder named "Google Earth" and save it there. If it saves to your user downloads, navigate to that folder, select copy and then paste it to the Google Earth folder that you created.
