

**DEDICATION CERTIFICATE**

STATE OF NEW MEXICO

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned James F. Mahill, and Frances S. Mahill, being the owners and proprietors of a certain tract of land, hereinafter more fully described and being a part of the:

Southwest quarter of the Northeast, and a part of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast, at Section 26 township 16 south, range 14 East, N.M.P.M.,

which said tract of land is more fully described as follows to-wit:  
Beginning at a point on the West line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Sixteen (16) South, Range Fourteen (14) East, N.M.P.M., in Otero County, New Mexico, from which point the Center Quarter corner of the said Section Twenty-six (26) bears South one degree, thirty-two minutes East (S1°-32'E) a distance of three hundred fourteen and three-tenths feet (314.3 Ft.). Thence, North one degree, thirty-two minutes West (N1°-32'W) along the West line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the said Section Twenty-six (26) a distance of one thousand one hundred thirty-eight and three-tenths feet (1138.3 Ft.) to the Northwest corner of the said Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the said Section Twenty-six (26); Thence, South eighty-nine degrees, forty-four minutes East (S89°-44'E) along the North line of the said Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the said Section Twenty-six (26) a distance of one thousand three hundred twenty-five and five-tenths feet (1325.5 Ft.) to the Northeast corner of the said Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the said Section Twenty-six (26), which point is also the Northeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the said Section Twenty-six (26); Thence, South eighty-nine degrees, forty-four minutes East (S89°-44'E) a distance of one hundred twenty-seven and seven-tenths feet (127.7 Ft.) to a point on the North line of the said Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the said Section Twenty-six (26), which point is also on the West right-of-way line of New Mexico State Highway No. 83; Thence, South thirty-one degrees, thirty-four minutes West (S31°-34'W) along the west right-of-way line of the said State Highway No. 83 a distance of one hundred seventy and five-tenths feet (170.5 Ft.) to a point; Thence, continuing along the said west right-of-way line of the said State Highway No. 83 upon a true circular curve to the left, the radius of which is one thousand four and nine-tenths feet (1004.9 Ft.) and the interior angle of which is twenty-one degrees, thirty-four minutes (21°-34'), a distance of three hundred sixty-eight and four-tenths feet (368.4 Ft.) to a point in the said right-of-way line; Thence, South ten degrees, thirty-eight minutes West (S10°-38'W) along the said west right-of-way line of the said State Highway No. 83 a distance of eight hundred ten and eight-tenths feet (810.8 Ft.) to a point on the said west right-of-way line; Thence, South eighty-six degrees, sixteen minutes West (S86°-16'W) a distance of two hundred four and nine-tenths feet (204.9 Ft.) to a point; Thence, North two degrees, fifty-four minutes East (N2°-54'E) a distance of one hundred twenty-three feet (123.0 Ft.) to a point; Thence, South eighty-six degrees, thirteen minutes West (S86°-13'W) a distance of one hundred ninety-nine and eight-tenths feet (199.9 Ft.) to a point; Thence, South two degrees, fifty-four minutes West (S2°-54'W) a distance of one hundred twenty-two and nine-tenths feet (122.9 Ft.) to a point; Thence, South eighty-six degrees, thirteen minutes West (S86°-13'W) a distance of two hundred twenty-six feet (226.0 Ft.) to a point; Thence, North one degree, twenty-two minutes West (N1°-22'W) a distance of one hundred eighty-two and five-tenths feet (182.5 Ft.) to a point; Thence, North fifty degrees, thirteen minutes West (N50°-13'W) a distance of two hundred seventy-seven and five-tenths feet (277.5 Ft.) to a point; Thence, along a true circular curve to the left, the radius of which is eighty feet (80.0 Ft.) and the interior angle subtended is ninety-eight degrees, thirty-four minutes (98°-34') a distance of one hundred thirty-seven and six-tenths feet (137.6 Ft.) to a point; Thence, South thirty-one degrees, thirty-four minutes West (S31°-34'W) a distance of one hundred and five feet (105.0 Ft.) to a point; Thence, along a true circular curve to the right, the radius of which is one hundred sixty feet (160.0 Ft.) and the interior angle subtended is twenty-one degrees, thirty-six minutes (21°-36'), a distance of sixty and three-tenths feet (60.3 Ft.) to the point of beginning, the tract of land thus described by the aforesaid meets and bounds, courses and distances, containing thirty-two (32.0) acres of land, more or less, and desiring to subdivide the said tract into lots and blocks and streets, have, with their free consent and in accordance with said desire caused the foregoing map to be made and filed in the office of the County Clerk, of Otero County, New Mexico; but the making and filing of this map is not intended as and shall not be or constitute a dedication of any street to the use of the general public, or right thereto in the public, and the right to use and enjoy such streets shall remain a private right appurtenant to the ownership of said tracts and subdivisions aforesaid, subject to the right, however, of the undersigned or their successors, to lay and control pipelines, ditches or other water ways therein, or to use any portion of the same deemed necessary for the construction of reservoirs or lakes for the storage of water therein, and subject to the right of the undersigned and their successors to lay and control pipeline for the distribution of gas, or oil for fuel purposes, and subject to the right of the undersigned and their successors to erect, operate, and maintain pole lines for a telephone system or for the transmission of electric energy.
