This is to certify that the above and foregoing portion and subdivision in Otero County, New Mexico, to-wit:

The SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 36, T. 17 S. R. 13 E.; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 31, T. 17 S. R. 14 E.; and all that part of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 25; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 36, T. 17 S. R. 13 E. also all that part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 30, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 31, T. 17 S. R. 14 E., South of the line described as follows: Beginning at the quarter corner on the range lines between Ranges 13 and 14 in Twp. 17 S. N. M. P. M., this corner being the E. quarter of Sec. 25 in said Twp. 17 S. R. 13 E., thence south 40 chains to the SE corner of Sec. 25; Thence South 62° West 6.65 chains to Station #1; thence North 78° E. 46.25 chains to the east line of the Calkins land in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 30, T. 17 S. R. 14 E., Station #2; and beginning again at Station #1, Thence S. 78° West. 54 chains. Station #3; Thence North 10° West 3.65 chains Station #4; Thence South 80° W. 3.55 chains.
