KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the undersigned Melvin E. Tays and Helen D. Tays, his wife, and Rayford S. Kissiah and Billie P. Kissiah, his wife, as owners and proprietors of a certain tract of land described as follows, to wit:

All of Lot 430, Block 400 of the Dunn Addition to the Town of Alamogordo, Otero County, New Mexico, and all of the following described tract of land to wit:

A parcel of land lying partly within the South half of the SE 1/4 of Section 8, and partly within the North half of the NE 1/4 of Section 17, Township 16 South, Range 10 East, N.M.P.M., and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 3/4 inch pipe which is 549 feet East and 1,004 feet North of the SW corner of the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 17, said point being the South East corner of Block 400; thence North 89°57' West a distance of 153.9 feet; thence North 0°02' West a distance of 1,000.0 feet to a point 15 feet East and 5 feet North of the SE corner of Lot 600, Block 600 of the said Dunn Addition; thence South 89°57' East a distance of 2,254.2 feet; thence South 0°02' East a distance of 580.0 feet; thence North 89°57' West a distance of 2,100.3 feet; thence South 0°02' East a distance of 420.0 feet to point of beginning; said tract of land containing 31.46 acres more or less, being the same land embraced within the original boundaries of the Dyer Subdivision-Addition No. II of the City of Alamogordo, New Mexico, and desiring to further subdivide the said tract of land into lots and blocks and streets and alleys, with their free consent and in accordance with their said desire have caused the foregoing map to be made and filed in the Office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio Recorder of Otero County, New Mexico, and do hereby dedicate the said streets and alleys to the use of the public.
