

DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND SUBDIVISION OF NW 1/4 OF SECTION 4 A PORTION OF THE LINCOLN NATIONAL FOREST PROPERTY LINE

LOCATED WITHIN SECTION 4, T 18 S, R 13 E, N.M.P.M., OTERO COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

Note:

This survey was executed in accordance with the instructions set forth in the BLM "Manual of Instructions for the Survey of the Public Lands of the United States - 1973" using a 1 second direction theodolite and electronic distance measuring equipment. The direction of lines was determined by angular measurement from an initial bearing obtained from the official 1941 record for the north 1/2 mile of the west boundary of section 4. Distances were measured on the slope in feet and converted by vertical angle measurement to horizontal chains and links to the nearest link. All corners monumented as a result of this survey consist of an aluminum post, 2 1/2 ins. dia., 30 ins. long, with magnetic Forest Service cap stamped as shown in the field notes.

CERTIFICATION

This plat represents a record of the survey and monumentation of the NW 1/4 of section 4, T.18S., R.13E., N.M.P.M., Otero County, New Mexico, which constitutes a portion of the property boundaries of the Lincoln National Forest.

The original survey of T.18S., R.13E., was executed by Sherrard Coleman, U.S. Deputy Surveyor in 1891. A Dependent resurvey was made in 1941 by A. Parker Warner, Surveyor of the U.S. General Land Office and is a record of the Bureau of Land Management in Santa Fe.

This survey, monumentation and record thereof is for the purpose of identifying and perpetuating the evidence of the previous official surveys, was made at the request of the Supervisor, Lincoln National Forest and is intended for his exclusive use.



with cap mkd.

dist., mkd. X BT. Attach FS Sign 54-3.
No other suitable trees near.
Corner is on steep west slope.

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 28 ins. in ground,
with cap mkd.
