Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 18 ins. in ground on bedrock, with cap mkd.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.57°E., 22 lks. dist., mkd. X BT. Attach FS Sign 54-3.
Build a mound of stone 3 ft. base around corner monument to top of cap.

SW 1/16 CORNER OF SECTION 32

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 6 ins. in ground on bedrock with cap mkd.

Build a mound of stone around corner monument, 4 ft. base to top of cap.

Corner is 7 ft. north of barbed wire fence line extending E - W.



This plat represents a record of the survey, subdivision and monumentation of section 32, T.15S., R.13E., N.M.P.M., Otero County, New Mexico, which constitutes a portion of the property boundaries of the Lincoln National Forest.

The original survey of T.15S., R.13E., was executed by John Shaw, U.S. Deputy Surveyor in 1884. A Dependent Resurvey was made in 1938 by Clark Gumm of the U.S. General Land Office. The north and east boundaries of section 32 were resurveyed by Shirley B. Hjellum, Supervisory Cadastral Surveyor of the Bureau of Land Management in 1978. These surveys are a record of the BLM in Santa Fe.

This survey, subdivision, monumentation and record thereof is for the purpose of identifying and perpetuating the evidence of the previous official surveys, was made at the request of the Supervisor, Lincoln National Forest and is intended for his exclusive use.

Note:


This survey was executed in accordance with the instructions set forth in the BLM "Manual of Instructions for the Survey of the Public Lands of the United States - 1973" using a 1 second direction theodolite and electronic distance measuring equipment. The direction of lines was determined by angular measurement from an initial bearing obtained from the official 1938 record for the east 1/2 mile of the south boundary of section 32. Distances were measured on the slope in feet and converted by vertical angle measurement to horizontal chains and links to the nearest link. All corners monumented as a result of this survey consist of an aluminum post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 30 ins. long, with magnetic Forest Service cap stamped as shown in the field notes.



- 54-2 Property Boundary
