

LEGAL DESCRIPTION  
 STA 123

Beginning at the 1/16-100 corner between Sections 4 and 5; thence S 87°29' W along the one-sixteenth line a distance of 42.87 feet to AP-1; thence N 20°22' E, a distance of 122.48 feet to a point on the line between Sections 4 and 5, to AP-2; thence S 00°06' E, a distance of 112.94 feet to the 1/16-100 corner, the place of beginning.

Said parcel contains 0.056 acres.



BASIS OF BEARING

The bearings of this survey are based on the 1980 BLM record bearing of N 00°06' W from the 1/16-100 corner to the 1/64-110 corner on the line between Section 4 and 5.

NATURE AND PURPOSE OF SURVEY

This survey was performed at the request of the USDA-Forest Service for the purpose of identifying the parcel known as Small Tracts Act No. 123 to be conveyed under authority of the Small Tracts Act, Public Law 97-485 (36C.F.R., Part 254).



NOTES:
